- Sterling Ridge had 4 DWI arrests for the month of December 2020.
- 11 Motor vehicle crashes in Sterling Ridge. Area of concern; Woodlands Parkway and FM 2978.
- Reminder to establish a daily 9 PM Routine of closing and locking all doors to homes & cars.
- 3) **Guest Speaker**: <u>Fire Chief Palmer Buck</u>: The Woodlands Fire Department We saw a decrease in calls in 2020, with is a 16% drop off. There was a 14% drop-off in EMS calls. In total, there were 215 fire calls and 5,072 EMS calls last year. The WFD is continuing to work with the MCHD to keep fire fighters safe; 30 employees have, at some time in the past year, tested COVID positive and 56 firefighters have been vaccinated over the past two weeks. There was a fire in May Valley on New Year's caused by the resident putting fireworks in a trashcan. There are 140 firefighters working on the trucks and an additional 30 employees in the fire department. The WFD would like a second company at Fire Station 5 (Branch Crossing) as Magnolia Fire Department comes and assist when needed. The Board questioned and discussed the structural issues involving the foundation at Fire Station 5.
