- 5) Township/Village Liaison Report(s): John Osborne
 - a. Update from The Woodlands Township Director Dr. Ann Snyder presented an update on items

from The Woodlands Township, including the Labor Day festivities, discussed the SRVA Artisans & Farmer's Market, The Woodlands AA+ Bond Rating (the highest bond rating in Texas for an unincorporated community), the budget meeting is on August 16th, the COVID testing sites, continuing discussions of the Performing Arts Center, Township Night Out is this month, and the history of incorporation of The Woodlands. In 2018 a consultant was hired to study incorporation, in 2020 a tax rate was approved but incorporation discussions were put on hold until June 2021 because of the pandemic.
