#### **Meeting Minutes:**

1) Meeting called to order by Tom Schwarzkopf at 7:08 PM.

- Overall trends for DWI/PI/Narcotics: Public Intoxication decreased, while DWI and Narcotics increased slightly from the previous month.
- Overall trends for Burglaries (all) and criminal mischief: Burglary of Building, Habitat, and Vehicles increased from the previous month and Criminal Mischief decreased.
- Sterling Ridge had 1 DWI arrests for the month of <u>October</u>.
- 13 Motor vehicle crashes in Sterling Ridge. The area of concern is FM 2978 due to the roadway construction.
- Reminder to establish a daily 9 PM Routine of closing and locking all doors to homes & cars.
- The Montgomery County Sherriff's Department is putting together a program for autism. A home/auto sticker that allows officers to know that that person in the car or home has autistic characteristics. Officers will be trained in this program. This will be included in the Smart 911 app. There was discussion about a psychologist that gave a presentation on suicide prevention.
- 3) Guest Speaker: We did not have any guest speakers.
- 4) Public Comment(s): None planned at this time
- 5) Approval of Minutes:
  - a. Minutes from October 2020 meeting were reviewed by the board.
  - b. Revisions: There were no revisions to the October minutes.
  - c. There was little discussion on the minutes. Having no unresolved revisions to the meeting minutes, Tom Schwarzkopf made a motion to approve (ratify) the minutes from the October 2020 meeting; Fred Lederman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- 6) Consideration of Appointment to fill vacant SRVA Board Member position (if needed): None needed
- 7) Township/Village Liaison Report:
  - a. Tom reviewed the report from Dr. Snyder. The Woodlands event calendar will be included with the minutes which extends through January 2021.
- 8) President's Report
  - a. Preliminary Budget for 2021 (See attached 2021 Budget). Tom Schwarzkopf reviewed the

budget for 2021. This is the same as the 2020 budget. The Board, however, is planning a Farmer's Market next year, which will be budgeted closer to the event. There was an increase in the storage unit fee by \$11/month. A question from Stan Lenox was discussed on the financial effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. Tom Schwarzkopf discussed the two events the Village has every year and The Woodlands Township provides \$12,500 to SRVA for restricted use. The Board will review and approve an updated 2021 budget at the January 2021 meeting.

- b. Holiday Lighting Contest is hosted by The Woodlands Township and conducted by each Village. Tom Schwarzkopf passed around a sign-up sheet for judges. There are three rounds. The first round is to find the five best in each section, the second round is to narrow it down to 5 houses, and the final round is to pick the winner. The lighting contest will begin December 10<sup>th</sup>.
- c. Upcoming SRVA Board elections on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021. The odd year board members are up for re-election. Discussion on the process of running and who is planning on running occurred. The sign-up period will begin December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 and run through January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
- d. TWT/SRVA Service Agreement for 2020 has been submitted by Tom Schwarzkopf
- e. SRVA Holiday Party. The Board discussed having a December holiday party, which will not occur because of COVID-19.
- f. Submit by the 15<sup>th</sup> article for The Woodlands magazine for January. Tom will send information on the A&FM to Steve who will prepare the article for the January issue.
- 9) Treasurer's Report: Rashmi Gupta
  - a. Rashmi Gupta presented an overview of the SRVA financial situation (See two attachments). Tom Schwarzkopf discussed the sponsorships that did not occur this year. Woodforest Bank gave a sponsorship last January for the BBQ and Tom will ask if they want to roll it over to next year. SRVA has \$4,900 less in revenue this year because of cancellations due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Discussion occurred on the steps to change the bank signatories. A Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Tom Schwarzkopf and seconded by Fred Lederman. The Motion passed.
  - b. Approve Budget Amendments (as needed). There were no budget amendments.
- 10) Events Chair Report (Robbye Schwarzkopf, Natalia Arjona, Fred Lederman, Lindsay Guier)
  - a. SRVA Farmer's Market Fred gave an update on the status of the Farmer's Market. The YMCA, the Library and the Kroger Shopping Center were not agreeable to hosting the Farmer's Market. There were two shopping centers that agreed to locate a Farmer's Market, which were the Gringo's and Dairy Queen Shopping Centers. The Board members chose the Dairy Queen location after hearing the pro's and the cons of each. A start date in December was discussed but January was selected for a soft start. The Board discussed utilizing EW Media for management. Tom and Robbye Schwarzkopf abstained from the discussion due to a personal connection to the vendor. Rashmi Gupta made a motion to hire EW Media; Natalia Arjona seconded the motion. The motion passed (5 votes passed the Motion).
  - b. Insurance. Due to the cancellation of events, it was requested from the insurance agent to provide a discount on the insurance which was denied. Fred Lederman is going to investigate other insurance options.

- c. The Woodlands Magazine Steve DiGerlando will submit the January article.
- d. Interfaith Food Drive The Food Drive went ok. The lessons learned included increased advertisement and promotion the next time.
- e. Lighting Competition Natalia Arjona is the Team Captain, Rashmi Gupta is Area 1 judge, Steve DiGerlando is Area 2 Judge, Eric Fishnaut is Area 3 Judge, Fred Lederman is Area 4 Judge, Tom and Robbye Schwarzkopf are the Area 5 Judges. Round 1 starts on December 10<sup>th</sup> and lasts five days.
- 12) New Business
  - a. No new business. There will not be a meeting in December 2020.
- 13) The next SRVA meeting will be Thursday, January 7th, at 7:00 PM. Tom Schwarzkopf made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Eric Fishhaut seconded the motion. The motion passed.
